

Jenison Public Schools - 98c Learning Loss Plan

The State of Michigan announced in September that a new grant was available to schools, and has allocated over \$52 million to Section 98c for Learning Loss. The JPS District will be applying for this grant and if approved, it will use the funding for intervention to target learning loss in the district.

The funds will be used to support Intervention Specialists and Special Education staff to help address learning loss and academically struggling students as documented by NWEA and/or Acadience testing for identified students of need.

We are hopeful to receive close to \$200,000 to help fund 8-10 intervention specialists for kindergarten to 6th grade students, identified based on need for reading and/or math support, depending on the final allocation awarded.

Potential Budget:

Possible 8+ Teachers, a percentage of salary, up to the amount awarded for the grant.
