Update Your Students Emergency Information

After School Arrangements

In the morning before your children come to school, please let them know where they will be going after school, who will be picking them up, and if they need to ride the bus. It is very disruptive to classroom learning when the office has to call down to the classrooms to let children know their after school plans. Children can also become very anxious when they don't know their plans and have to try and call parents for this information. Thank you for your cooperation!

Flip Flops

Flip flops are not the safest choice for students to wear to school. We have many injuries to toes and feet that could be avoided if the students were wearing shoes. If your child chooses to wear flip flops to school, could you please send a pair of shoes with them in their backpack? We have many students whose flip flops break and then they need to call home for shoes. They also need shoes for gym class, and could also wear their shoes when they go out for recess. Reporting Your Child's Absences

If your child is going to be absent, please contact the school by 8:50am. Our attendance line is 616-667-3550. Please remember to state the reason your child is missing school. If they are ill, please list their symptoms in your message. If we do not hear from you, we will try to contact you or someone listed on your emergency list. We urge you not to send a child to school if any illness is present. If a child becomes ill at school, parents will be contacted immediately.

No Dogs on School Property

Rosewood Elementary acknowledges the important role that pets, dogs in particular, play in our community and the positive impact dogs can have on family life. Recently, however, more dogs are being brought onto school grounds. This has the potential to increase the risk of injury to children caused by dogs (bites, scratches) through dogs reacting adversely to unexpected noise and/or movement of children. Some of our students are allergic and/or scared of dogs so we are asking that no dogs be on school grounds from 8:20am-4:00pm. Also, if you bring your dog onto our school property after hours, please help us keep our playground clean by cleaning up after your dog. We appreciate your help in keeping our students safe and our playground clean.

Inclusion Spirit Week

Young people with disabilities do not often get a chance to play on their school sports teams.

In more than 8,300 Unified Champion Schools across the country, Special Olympics has trained and mobilized youth leaders and educators to create more inclusive schools by including students with intellectual disabilities in all aspects of school life. Social inclusion is promoted by bringing together young people with and without intellectual disabilities on sports teams, through inclusive student clubs, and by fostering youth leadership. As many as 19.5 million young people are taking part in these experiences, which are increasing acceptance of people of all abilities. We are fortunate to have unified sports teams in Jenison, and next week we get to celebrate our Unified Sports teams by having special spirit days.

Box Tops may be submitted at any time using the Box Tops app (direction on the next page).

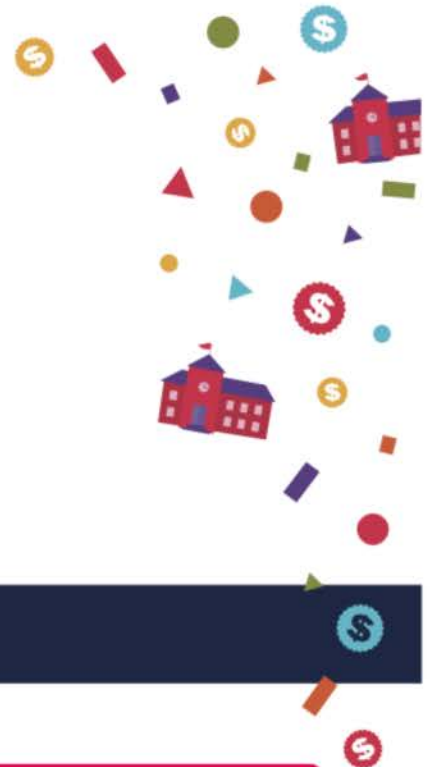

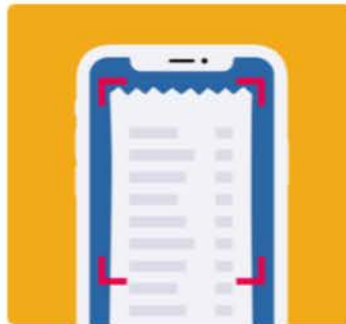

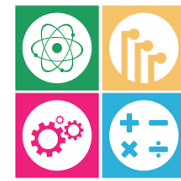

Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Miles of Smiles (MOS) dental program was established in 1995 and provides dental services for children at approximately 30 Ottawa County Schools annually. The mobile unit is 40 feet long, has 2 patient rooms, digital x-ray, waiting area and a wheelchair lift. Unfortunately, MOS will not be visiting your child's school this year. However, we want to inform you that your child can be seen on our mobile unit when we locate at another Ottawa County School.

If your child/children have the qualifications listed below, please use the link or QR code to complete the dental consent form for each of your children.

To qualify for NO COST dental services:

- Your child must not have a dentist
- Your child has not had a dental checkup in the last 6 months
- Your child has Medicaid Insurance or is uninsured and financially qualifies
- Your child lives or attends school in Ottawa County
