Each grade level will be in charge of their own party. They will reach out to you with any supplies needed or volunteer opportunities. Parties are only open to parents who are volunteering.

We will be outside & will begin our parade at 3:15pm, weather permitting. We ask that all parents line up around the school building. (Please see map below.) Students will be dismissed to go home when the parade is completed at 3:35pm. For our parents who like to dress up, please **do not wear any masks** that cover your face. For safety reasons, we need to see the faces of all of our visitors. If you are attending, please be considerate of our neighbors & mindful of where you park your vehicle. Do NOT block driveways!



Calling In An Absence

When your child will be absent from school, please call the attendance line (616.667.3550) prior to 9:00am. In your voicemail message, please include the following items:

- Student's name with the spelling of their last name
- Student's grade & teacher
- Reason for your student's absence. If your child is absent due to illness, please include their symptoms.
- Your relation to the student.
- If your student is coming in late, please indicate their lunch choice. (white, blue, or cold)

Our Rosewood Run was a BLAST! Our hope is for students to have a lifelong connection that getting up and active for a cause is FUN!


