- *Absolutely no weapons, real or plastic
- *No clown costumes
- *No costumes that depict bloody, violent, or gory situations
- *No costumes depicting language or graphics outside of the school dress code

Costumes are subject to administrator discretion. Students dressed inappropriately will be asked to change. If a student is wearing a mask, please make sure they can see well. Please have your child bring their costume to school rather than wear it.

Halloween Parties & Parade

Each grade level will be in charge of their own party. They will reach out to you with any supplies needed or volunteer opportunities. Parties are only open to parents who are volunteering & have completed their background check.

We will be outside & will begin our parade at 3:15pm, weather permitting. We ask that all parents line up around the school building. (More information will be sent home soon regarding this.) Students will be dismissed to go home when the parade is completed at 3:30pm. For our parents who like to dress up, please **do not wear any masks that cover your face.** For safety reasons, we need to see the faces of all of our visitors.



Dear Parents,

Rosewood will once again be using PowerPTC to schedule parent-teacher conferences! With the use of technology, PowerPTC allows you, our parents/guardians, to select the time and dates that work best with your schedule. For families with multiple households, please only schedule one parent/teacher conference per student.

The following is our parent-teacher conference schedule for October 2023:

Tuesday, October 24, 2023 4:00pm - 8:30pm OR Thursday, October 26, 2023 4:00pm - 8:30pm

For families with <u>more than one student</u> in the building, the scheduling window opens Friday, October 6. For families with only <u>one student</u> in the building, please wait until Monday, October 9 to schedule your conference. This will allow our families with multiple students to try to schedule conferences together. **The scheduling window will close for everyone on Sunday, October 22 at 4pm.**

Please follow the instructions below to schedule conferences through PowerPTC. Instructions are embedded to set up a PowerSchool Parent account if you do not have one. You must set up a PowerSchool account before you can schedule a conference. PowerSchool Parent Access Information letters are going home in Friday folders today.


