

What Mason Tenders do?

- Cut materials to specified sizes for installation, using power saws.
- Stocks material, Supplies Bricklayer
- Erect scaffolding or other installation structures.
- Prepare mortar and grout.
- General clean-up of debris.
- Arrange or store materials, tools, or equipment.
- Remove damaged brick or mortar, and clean or prepare surfaces, using hammers, chisels, drills.
- Locate and prepare materials for masons to install, possibly following drawings or numbered sequences.
- Clean block walls, prepare for paint.
- Move or position materials such as stone slabs, steel elements using cranes, hoists, or dollies.

What work activities are most important?

- Handling and Moving Objects - Using hands and arms in handling, installing, positioning, and moving materials, and manipulating things.
- Getting Information - Observing, receiving, and otherwise obtaining information from all relevant sources.
- Making Decisions and Solving Problems - Analyzing information and evaluating results to choose the best solution and solve problems.
- Performing General Physical Activities - Performing physical activities that require considerable use of your arms and legs and moving your whole body, such as climbing, lifting, balancing, walking, stooping, and handling of materials
- Identifying Objects, Actions, and Events - Identifying information by categorizing, estimating, recognizing differences or similarities, and detecting changes in circumstances or events.
- Monitor Processes, Materials, or Surroundings - Monitoring and reviewing information from materials, events, or the environment, to detect or assess problems.
- Operating Vehicles, Mechanized Devices, or Equipment - Running, maneuvering, navigating, or driving vehicles or mechanized equipment, such as forklifts.
- Controlling Machines and Processes - Using either control mechanisms or direct physical activity to operate machines or processes.
- Communicating with Supervisors, Peers, or Subordinates - Providing and receiving information to supervisors, co-workers, and subordinates.
- Organizing, Planning, and Prioritizing Work - Developing specific goals and plans to prioritize, organize, and accomplish your work.
- The ability to work safely. Comply with MIOSHA & OSHA requirements.
