Dual Enrollment

- 1. On April 1, 1996, Public Act 160 created the Postsecondary Enrollment Options Act which allows school districts to assist students in paying for tuition and fees for course work at higher institutions of learning in Michigan based on the following conditions:
- 2. Student is enrolled in grade 11 or 12 in an approved program which will provide all credit requirements for high school graduation.
- 3. Student must have taken the Michigan Merit Examination (MME).
- 4. The student must have been accepted by the college or university to enroll in course work.
- 5. Student must be enrolled at Jenison High School and the post secondary institution during the regular academic year and must be enrolled in at least one high school course.
- 6. The college courses are not offered at Jenison High School.
- 7. The college courses cannot be a hobby, craft or recreation course, or in the subject areas of physical education, theology, divinity, or religious education.
